

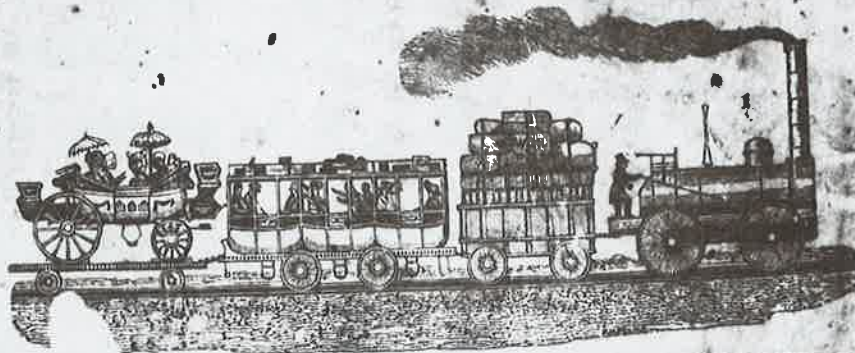

ARRANGEMENT.

A Packet BOAT will leave **Schenectady**
Daily, for **Utica, Rochester and Buffalo**, at

Half past 10 o'clock A. M., and

Half past 6 o'clock P. M.

PASSENGERS for the **PACKETS** will leave **Albany**
by the **CARS** at **9 A. M.** and **5 P. M.**

These are the only **Cars** that run to the **Packets**.

By this arrangement there is no delay, as the **Packets** will
leave **Schenectady** immediately after the arrival of the **Cars**.
